**ARTICLE 1.** To elect by written ballot a Moderator to preside at said Meeting.

**ARTICLE 2.** To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Municipal Officers to use an amount not to exceed \$70,300 from Undesignated Fund Balance for 2019-20 Winter Roads Maintenance.

(In June voters approved \$147,000 for the winter maintenance of roads. In July, the Municipal Officers were notified that the vendor, contracted by Chelsea to provide winter maintenance, was opting out of the  $2^{nd}$  and  $3^{rd}$  year of the contract. The Municipal Officers requested bids and received one bid of \$217,300. The \$70,300 is the additional amount needed for winter maintenance of roads in 2019-20)
