I. Call meeting to order:

V. Scheduled Items:

A. New Business –

1. Copier Lease Review

The Manager explained to the Selectboard that the current 60-month lease of the Xerox 5335 copier has expired. The plan is to relace the current black and white copier and Brother HL-L8360CDW with a color copier and printer. The replacement would be a Xerox C8135. The savings would be roughly \$50 per month. The Manager explained that he would prefer to purchase from Transco Business Technologies because of the excellent customer service Chelsea receives.

The Selectboard supported the Managers recommendation.

2. Summer Roads Spending Revisions

The Manager explained to the Selectboard that due to the overspending last fall to correct road drainage issues in various locations around town, there were not enough funds remaining to finish some roads projects. This Spring funds would be spent applying the final inch of overlay to Mud Mill Rd and Hillcrest Drive. There would also be \$45,000 redirected to Dondero Road to begin the process of rebuilding the road.

B. Old Business –

Based on the positive feedback at the Public Hearing, the Selectboard expressed there own support of the **Omnibus TIF and Development Plan.**

2. Approve March 23, 2022 Special Town Meeting Warrant

The Manager presented the Selectboard with a draft of the March 23, 2022 Special Town Meeting Warrant.

A motion was made by Pushard that was seconded by Truman to approve the warrant calling for a Special Town Meeting march23, 2022 at 6PM. The vote was unanimous of those present and voting.

The Age Friendly Committee presented to the Selectboard their January 1, 2022 to June 30, 2022 Budget and their July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023 Budget. Both budgets include funds to conduct monthly concerts and Senior Lunches. There was support for the purchase of a tent instead of renting one.

A motion was made by Pushard that was seconded by Truman to approve the Age Friendly Committees January 1, 2022 to June 30, 2022 and July 1, 2022 to June 30, 2023 Budget. The vote was unanimous of those present and voting.
