 - Adding requirements for licensing, public hearings, and buffering (200 feet minimum from residential properties).
 - Discussion about whether permits should be transferable if a business changes ownership, with suggestions to allow for smoother transitions while maintaining standards.

Blasting and Mining Ordinance:

Neighborhood Protection Standards:

• Natalie Thomsen introduced standards from other communities aimed at reducing the impact of commercial properties on residential neighborhoods.

Camper Ordinance:

- Reviewed language in Article 6, Section 6.1 D regarding private campsite permits.
 - Proposed clarification: No permits to be issued between November 1 and April 29.
 - Investigate occupancy standards and camper safety requirements (e.g., egress).
